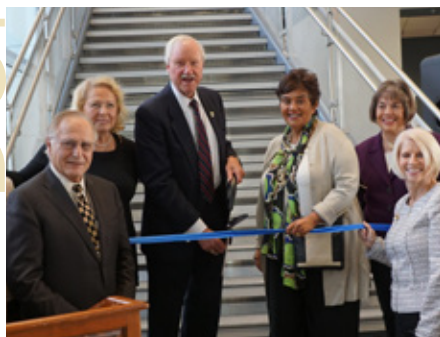




## Grunin Foundation

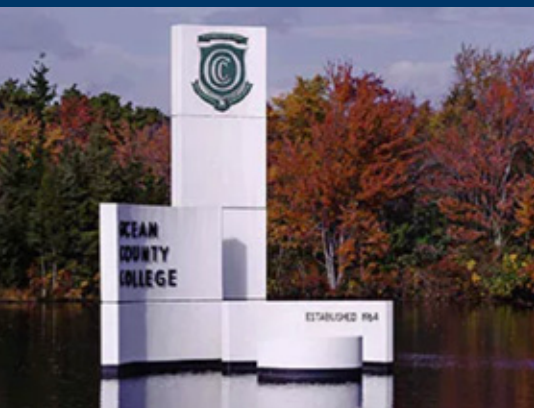
